	<ol> <li>Green Street: Residents requested an update on Green Street following discussion during the May meeting where grave safety issues were raised. It was noted that little progress had been made. The meeting was of the opinion that the Infrastructure Minister should be invited to a future meeting to be briefed on this and other issues (SC to action). Tristan Dodd had emailed regarding the traffic calming and the absence of crossings. Further consultation will be undertaken as part of the Neighbourhood Improvement Area work and the issue will be revisited. The raised table in front of the Ommaroo has not been installed as a crossing due to supply shortages of the flashing studs.</li> <li>Seaside Festival: The Festival is planned for 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> July, to be carried out by Jason Maindonald. 	<b>Parking issues</b> : Disappointment was expressed that Planning has revised parking spaces on the old Sovereign Car Hire site. This has been appealed, but there is a policy to prevent commuters parking on the outskirts of St Helier. Residents contend the policy is being misused as the application was for residents' parking. The meeting voted to support further action to create parking at the site.	
5	Any other business	
	<b>The Lido</b> : The tenant gave an overview of the issues and challenges, including the lease and poor maintenance of the building. Following the success of the States debate (P.61/2022), the Private Secretary for the Infrastructure Minister updated the meeting on the formation of the political steering group, which has stalled during the election period. The tenant was unclear whether he could trade and open the kiosk without the steering group being in place. Residents were of the opinion that this was not the intention of the proposition.
