Presentation from Ports of Jersey	Tom Wright and Joe Edmunds presented confirming that they are part of the design and construction team of the new port. It was confirmed that initial plans have now got planning approval. It was confirmed that a lot of preparatory work required prior to the re-
	development of the main Harbour building. It was noted that it is estimated that works will start in September 2026 and should be completed by Winter 2028.
	It was confirmed that regular briefings will be provided to the group as progress is made.
	It was confirmed that the Terminal itself is 5 years away and any update to the parking layout will take place later in the project.
	It was confirmed that the project is solely funded by the Ports of Jersey.
	It was reported that the La Folie Pub site has moved into Phase 2 – identification of what the community wants and any commercial opportunities that may arise.
	Continuing issues around the bollards in the area were noted. Mixture of locked / unlocked.
