3. Matters arising –

Much of the discussion was around the topics that are regularly discussed but which still await resolution

Policing of parking at Castle Quay – why is no one taking responsibility? Police, Honorary Police, Traffic wardens. Very little in the way of visibility and no policing at all after 17.30.

The lack of infrastructure for commercial parking and with greater traffic anticipated following the completion of the Horizon development questions were raised as to the capacity of Rue du Port Elizabeth.

Installation of crossings outside Castle Quay

The issue of re-cycling bins around La Fregate was also raised with the lids of these bins being particularly difficult to open

At the last meeting there was a request made for emergency service access bollards at La Fregate, however no progress has been made.
