Meeting Tuesday 31st January 2023

1. Apologies – Deputy Tom Coles, Constable Simon Crowcroft
2. Minutes of meeting 29th November 2022 approved
3. Matters arising –

Crossings on Rue du L'Eteau awaiting funding from sale of Horizon properties. Promised a Feb 2023 update by which time St. Helier roads committee should have given the go ahead. Feedback is that Parish of St. Helier have no plans in place for any work to date.

Sylvia highlighted some issues with uneven pavements in the Marina Garden area, this is under the management of SOJDC. No corrective work appears to have been carried out.

Following on discussions:

- There have been 3 bicycle thefts from the Millais House parking area. This has resulted in entry locks being moved.
 - Illegal parking on Rue du L'Eteau still unresolved
 - Lack of a bigger infrastructure plan for the area
 - Standing water in Evie bike area – more uneven paving ?
 - SOJDC – lighting issues to be resolved
 - Promenade – Contracting vans blocking promenade. Issues around access for Ambulance and Fire Service.
 - Concern over Fire assembly point for Horizon flats – no plan
 - Suggestion that the Rue du L'Eteau should be “access only”, however this appears to be unlikely.
 - Cherry pickers causing roads to be blocked
 - Lack of communication between Parish / SOJDC / Ports
4. There was no update report from SOJDC
 5. There was no update from St. Helier honorary police
 6. Any other business
 - Given the serious nature of the safety concerns expressed at the meeting Deputy Warr has written to the Constable, IHE, HA and SOJDC and copied all St. Helier Deputies on the 31/1/2023. bringing these issues to their attention.
