## PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St. Helier will be held at 7pm on Wednesday 27 April 2022 at the Town Hall;

Parishioners are asked to take into consideration and, if deemed advisable:

1. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on 23 February 2022\*;
2. To elect a Constable's Officer for the Canton de Bas de la Vingtaine de la Ville;
3. To elect a Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine de Bas du Mont au Prêtre;
4. To elect a Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine du Mont a l'Abbe;
5. To approve the recommendation of the Connétable and Procureurs du Bien Public that the proposition requesting that proposals to form the Conseil Municipal for St Helier are included in the new Government Plan is lodged by the Connétable in the next States Assembly for debate later this year P.01/2022\*;
6. To consider an application by ArtHouse Jersey to use its recently acquired space of the Ground Floor at Capital House, 8 Church Street for a Bailiff's Annual Entertainment permit; to enable visual art exhibitions, dance, theatre, poetry, music performances, films and creative talks and workshops to take place. Opening hours are typically two weeks for exhibitions with the venue closed to the public on Mondays. There is usually 7 – 10 days turn around for changing exhibitions, but apart from this ArtHouse plans to run a programme of events on a continuous basis
