- 5. To note in accordance with article 42 (5) of the Marriage and Civil Status (Jersey) Law 2001, the Constable's appointment of Claire Follain, Superintendent Registrar, to undertake St Helier's Registrar function; initially for a period of 2 years at which time the matter will be reviewed.
