

## PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St. Helier will be held at 7pm on Wednesday 29 September 2021 at the Town Hall;

Parishioners are asked to take into consideration and, if deemed advisable:

- 1. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on 25 August 2021\*;
- 2. To elect a Constable's Officer for the Canton de Haut de la Vingtaine de la Ville;
- 3. To approve a recommendation of the Roads Committee and Procureurs du Bien Public to accept a gift of a section of land alongside Cransworth Apartments, La Vallée des Vaux, measuring approximately 55 sq.m., for the purpose of creating a new public footpath and increasing the width of the carriageway. The Assembly is to instruct the Connétable and at least one Procureur du Bien Public to pass a contract, with the owner paying all reasonable legal costs associated with the transfer P.05/2021\*; and
- 4. To consider an application by Shipwright Limited, holder of a first category licence in respect of premises known as The Shipwright, 2 Peirson Road, for a Bailiff's Annual Entertainment permit; to provide entertainment events, including small bands and DJ's and to take advantage of charity events and yearly events in the summer at People's Park.
