Every attempt will be made to accommodate people wishing to attend the Town Hall in person rather than using the online facility.

Parishioners who are in a high-risk Covid category, or are over 70 years of age, are encouraged to join the Assembly online. Where this is not possible, we advise you to consider carefully the risks of attending the Assembly.

The Parish is utilising a Covid track and trace system for those attending the Assembly in person.
