<b>66/22</b>	<b>Item 2: Following agreement of the Central Market Management, to consider an application by Francisco Javier Lora Reina in respect of premises 34 - 41 Central Market, St Helier, holder of a 3<sup>rd</sup> category licence, to vary the licence to remove/change the current specified hours for the sale of alcohol, to enable the restaurant to open on nights when Market Management are in agreement.</b>		
	<p><b>Proposer:</b> Juan Hilario <b>Seconder:</b> Michael Graham</p> <p>The application was presented by Francisco Reina, who explained that he is applying to remove/change the current specified hours for the sale of alcohol from his 3<sup>rd</sup> category licence for the premises, Casa Paco, 34 – 41 Central Market, to enable him to open on nights when the Market management are in agreement. He explained that the current restrictions on his licence have prevented him from selling alcohol on two occasions during this Christmas period.</p> <p>There were no questions from the Assembly, on being put to a vote the application was approved unanimously.</p>

	<p><b>Proposer:</b> Pedro Maia, <b>Seconder:</b> Michael Graham</p> <p>The application was presented by Jose Manuel Batista, who explained the company is applying for a 3<sup>rd</sup> category licence for premises Sip N' Snack, 13 Cheapside, which he purchased earlier this year and for which he became registered manager on 12<sup>th</sup> August 2022. When purchasing the premises, it was believed the licence was in a company name, but when he came to renew the licence, it became apparent that the licence had been held in the previous owner's name.</p> <p>There were no questions from the Assembly, on being put to a vote the application was approved unanimously.</p>
