21/21	Item 2: In conformity with Article 5 of the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie, to elect five members of the Roads Committee, whose terms of office will expire on 31st December 2023. This item was deferred due to the Covid19 Pandemic at a Parish Assembly on 9th December 2020, where the following nominations were received: John Baker; James Corbett; Jason Lagadu; Barry Le Feuvre; Bernie Manning; Mario Pirozzolo; Kevin Proctor and Ted Vibert.																
	<p>Nominees were requested to make a five-minute speech, outlining their experience, and what they can bring to the Roads Committee. Nominees were asked to include at least one answer, to five questions submitted by Parishioners.</p> <p>The Constable reminded the Assembly that there being eight candidates for the five vacancies a secret ballot would be held.
