97/20	Item 3: In conformity with Article 5 of the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie, to elect five members of the Assembly to act as officers of the Roads Committee for a term of three years.
	<p>The Constable made this statement: that following recent developments in Government's Covid guidelines, he has concluded that it is not safe or practicable to ask parishioners to attend an Assembly to elect members at this time.</p> <p>In order to meet legal requirements, the Assembly will receive nominations for members of the Roads Committee. If there are more candidates nominated than the five available positions, the election of those nominated will be deferred until May 2021,</p> <p>Before asking for nominations, the Constable offered his thanks to Robert Le Brocq and Julian Rogers who would not be seeking re-election. Mr Le Brocq has been a member of the Roads Committee since January 2012. Mr Rogers has been a member of the Roads Committee since January 2018.</p> <p>The Constable asked if there were any nominations from the Assembly, to fill the five vacancies for the Roads Committee for a three-year term.
