The Constable asked if there were any further nominations: no other persons came forward.

After the statutory 10 minutes required by Law the Constable declared John Nicholas Baker elected as a Procureur du Bien Public for the Parish of St. Helier.

The candidate was thanked by the Constable for putting his name forward for nomination, and he congratulated him on his successful election. The candidate was advised that he would be required to attend at the Royal Court on Friday 10 March 2023 at 10:00 hours to take the Procureur's Oath of Office.

The Constable said he would notify the Returning Officer, Jurat Robert Christensen M.B.E. and HM Attorney-General of the result of the meeting.

The Constable thanked Procureur Geraint Robert Jennings for his 26 years of service and dedication; he was first elected as a member of the Roads Committee in 1996 and re-elected in 1999, 2002, 2005, 2008 2011 2015, elected Procureur du Bien Public in 2016, re-elected in 2017 and 2020.

The Constable declared the meeting closed.
