The Constable said he would notify the Returning Officer Jurat Robert Christensen M.B.E, the Judicial Greffe and HM Attorney-General of the result

The Constable thanked:

Centenier Peter John Garrett for his 19 years of service and dedication; he was first elected as Constables Officer in August 2004, elected as Vingtenier in 2006, elected Centenier in 2008 and re-elected in 2011, 2014, 2017 and 2020;

Centenier Marta Cristina Rebelo Fontes for her 12 years of service and dedication; she was first elected as Constables Officer in July 2010 and re-elected in 2013, elected as Vingtenier in 2016, elected Centenier in 2016 and re-elected in 2017 and 2020.

The Constable declared the meeting officially closed.
