Procureur Peter Pearce asked if there were any further nominations: no other persons came forward.

As there were more candidates than vacancies, Procureur Pearce informed the meeting that the taking of a poll will be held on Wednesday, 13th December 2023, from 8am to 8pm.

Procureur Pearce advised the meeting that only registered voters as of midday, the previous day, 31st October 2023 are eligible to vote in this election. As this is a Parish Election, and in accordance with the Elections (Jersey Law), 2002, there is no Supplementary Register and no Postal and Pre-poll voting facility. Only those voters registered at the cut off can attend the poll in person to vote.

Procureur Pearce said he would notify the Returning Officer Jurat Robert Anthony Christensen of the outcome.

Procureur Pearce declared the meeting officially closed.
