	<p>Proposer: Sebastian Derda Seconder: Anna Lewandowska</p> <p>Helmut Fuchs spoke on behalf of a 6th category licence application, explaining that unfortunately having experienced a problem with his email, he had failed to renew his liquor licence at the end of 2023.</p> <p>Deputy Ahier asked the type of business and how long it had been operating. Mr Fuchs explained it was a general store, which is located next to the Fish Market. The store sold predominately Polish food, including meat, cheese etc.</p> <p>Deputy Andrews asked what the opening hours are. Mr Fuchs explained the opening hours of the store were 9am to 6.30pm Monday to Saturday and Sunday, 9am to 3pm.</p> <p>Deputy Ahier asked whether these opening hours are allowed under the Sunday Trading Law. It was explained that the Sunday Trading Law restricts larger stores from opening before 10am.</p> <p>There were no further questions from the Assembly, on being put to a vote the application was approved unanimously.</p>
