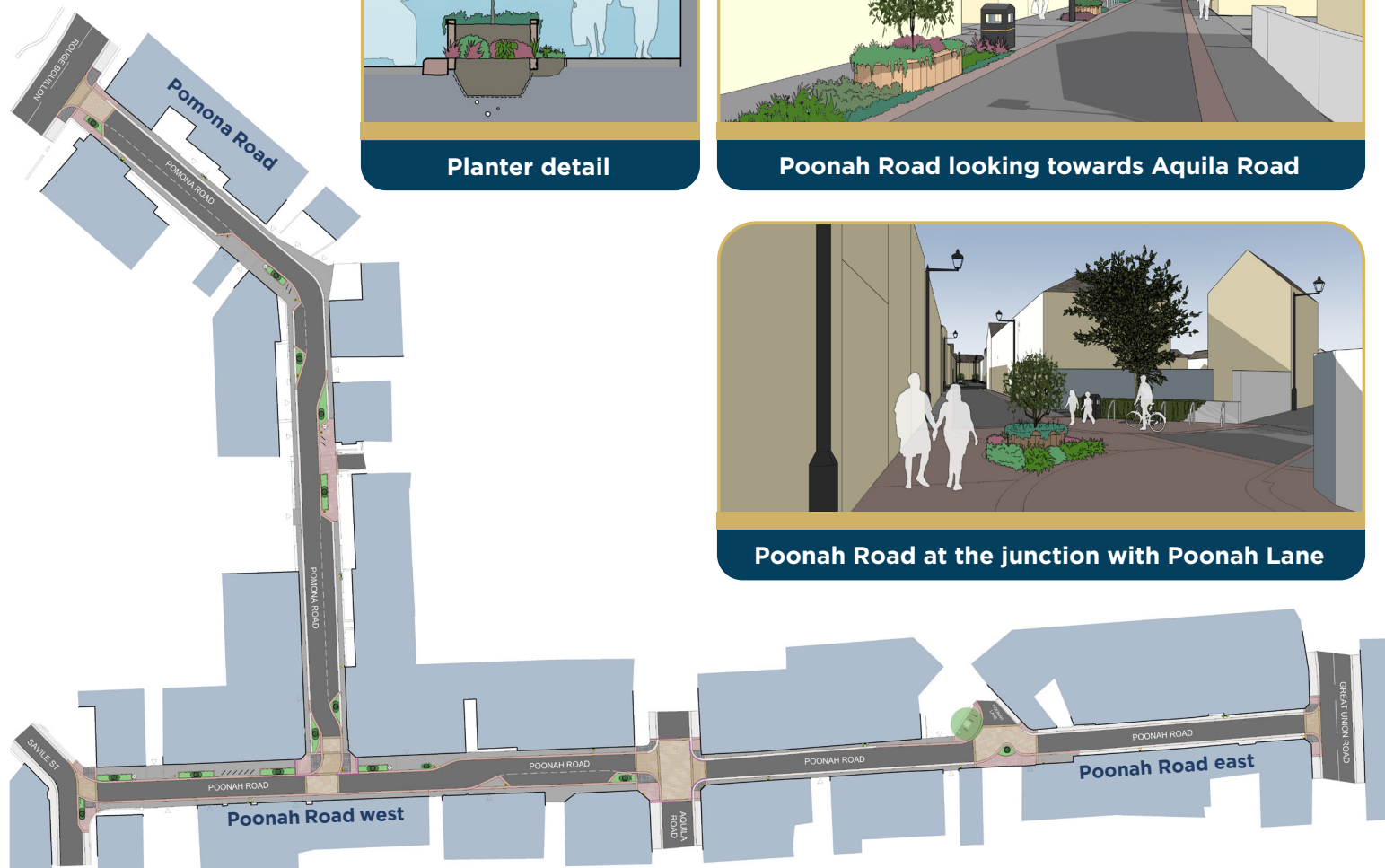
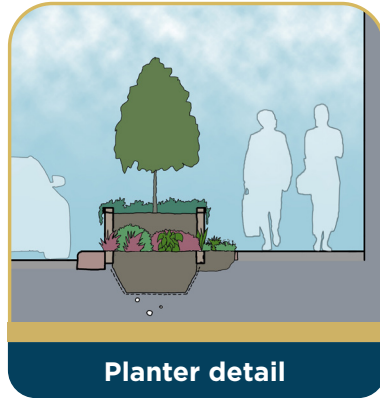

SCHEME BACKGROUND

Following the community consultation in June, our project team has progressed the detailed design. As part of this, trial pits were excavated to identify below-ground utilities at the proposed tree locations. Unfortunately, this revealed additional clashes, meaning sustainable tree planting is not possible.

In response to this issue, as well as concerns about shading of properties, an alternative design has been developed, including **more extensive ground-level planting beds, raised timber planters, a rhythmic pattern of feature shrubs and hanging baskets, with an automatic watering system.**

The developed scheme maintains the previous layout, with **increased pedestrian space, traffic-calming measures, high quality granite paving** and a **new lighting scheme with heritage-style columns and lanterns.**

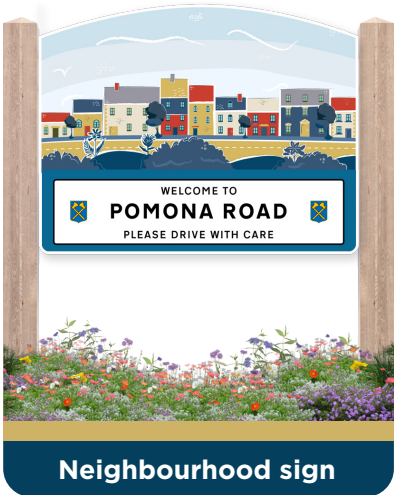

The illustrated scheme is to be delivered in phases, with **Phase 1 being Pomona Road**, with Poonah Road west and east as later phases.

The proposed programme is for construction to start on Pomona Road in early **January 2025, with completion by late Spring**. Works on Poonah Road are likely to follow in Autumn 2025.

Inevitably there will be some disruption to residents during the scheme delivery, as we expect there will need to be some access and parking restrictions during the works. However, the project team will seek to minimise inconvenience as far as possible, keeping residents informed as the works progress.
