

The Assembly Room



The Parish of St. Helier art collection that hangs in the Assembly Rooms of the Town was bequeathed to the Parish by Lucina Le Sueur. Her husband had inherited the collection from his brother, Pierre Le Sueur, who was Constable of St Helier between 1839 and 1853 and whose portrait also hangs in the Assembly Room (on loan from the Jersey Heritage Trust), alongside a companion piece portraying his arch rival, Francois Godfray.
