	<p>Proposer: Mihai Epure-Popescu Seconder: Cosmin Stroe</p> <p>Florin Beclenas spoke, as owner of the Wave Beach Restaurant, Havre des Pas, explaining that he is seeking a 3rd category licence to open a restaurant serving the local community. The restaurant will open between the hours of 12noon until 10.30pm, 7 days a week, and will serve delicious local produce and home cooked food, including seafood, burgers, and jacket potatoes, as well as speciality ice creams and homemade cakes. It will also run a takeaway service. Alcohol will be served on the premises subject to licensing agreement. It is requested that the licence be extended to cover a small alfresco area, directly in front of the premises, for which an application has been made to the Parish.</p> <p>Ian Gray explained that he worked for the owners of the next-door property and said that their main concern would be noise outside, he asked what steps would be taken to reduce the noise in a residential area. Mr Beclenas stated he would keep noise a minimum, as his type of restaurant would not create noise.</p> <p>Deputy Ahier asked about extending the licence to cover an alfresco area. He was advised that an alfresco area had previously been approved and what is being requested is smaller in size.</p> <p>There were no further questions from the Assembly, on being put to a vote the application was approved unanimously</p>
