Sitting next to Pierre Perrot is a wonderful portrait of his wife Mrs Caroline Perrot. Clearly Caroline is a lady of significant importance in Jersey in the 19th century as you will note her elegant dress and expensive jewellery. Other important attributes to note are the luxuriant sofa upon which she rests and that the artist has chosen to highlight her intellect with a book resting beneath her hands. It is also unusual to note the way her fingers are displayed in an unnatural pose.
