Directly below the romanticised cityscape we can see a beautiful 'Winter Scene' painted in oil on canvas by an unknown artist from the School of Schelfhout which is from roughly the same period.

It is still unclear but this painting was most likely painted by a student of Dutch artist Schelfhout who is well known for his winter scenes. He was a Dutch landscape painter but he also painted seascapes and was an accomplished watercolourist. In all of his works the artist tried to convey the moods of nature rather than produce a precise image of a landscape, as can be seen in this painting on display.
