	There being no other candidates Liana LE ROSSIGNOL was elected Vingtenier for the Vingtaine de Haut au Mont au Prêtre.		
	Procureur Pearce gave a vote of thanks for the many years of service conducted by Liana Le Rossignol who joined the Honorary Police in July 1999 as a Constable's Officer; she was elected Vingtenier in 2002 and reelected in 2005. On 27 August 2008 Liana was elected to the role of Centenier and on completion of that term in July 2010 she was once again elected as a Vingtenier, a role that expired on 4 July 2016. Mr Pearce thanked Mrs Le Rossignol for putting her name forward and formally warned her to appear before the Royal Court at 10am on Friday 16 August to take her Oath of Office.		

41/19	Item 5: Recommend to the Licensing Bench an application by Jose Alberto Melim holder of a Third Category licence for Gas Place Cafe, Shop 2, Park House, Gas Place, St Helier to extend the ambit of the licence to cover an existing and new outside area of the premises for which the applicant holds a Choses Publiques Permit;

	Advocate Tremoceiro presented the application stating that his client wished to extend the third category licence for the Cafe to cover the outside Chose Publique area of the premises, which is in Gas Place. The road the Café is situated on is closed to traffic and it makes the corner of Aspley Roads opposite the Millennium Park. The Licence has been in operation for some considerable period and there have been no complaints reported. Customers have asked to be served outside during the summer months, as it is a comfortable area in which to have a drink and failure to approve the application could considerably affect their custom. Advocate Tremoceiro advised that those operating the cafe were suitably responsible and that he would commend the application to the Assembly
	No questions were raised and on being put to the vote the application was approved unanimously.
