The total number of visitors to St Helier, Jersey - New for the last 52 weeks is 21,293,490 which is 6.5% down on the previous year.


The total number of visitors for the year to date is 9,699,343 which is 7.4% down on the previous year.

The peak hour of the week was 13:00 on Thursday 26 June 2025 with footfall of 9,419.











Footfall Counts by hour




Footfall Counts by week
