	<p>Proposer: John O’Connell Seconder: Samantha Morely</p> <p>Matthew Daly spoke on behalf of a 3rd category licence application for Luma Cafe. He is taking over the premises that is Roseville Café, which currently holds a 3rd Category licence. Whilst the name, branding and menu will change, the offering will be similar. There will be no alteration to the premises or the size of the alfresco area.</p> <p>The applicant has consulted with several businesses in the street, and they have all been supportive of his project; and he is keen to work with them in this rejuvenated area of St Helier. The fire inspection report identified a few areas of improvement, which were addressed within 48 hours and the certificate forwarded and acknowledged by the Fire department.</p> <p>Procureur Corbett asked the number of patrons for the premises. Mr Daly explained the number has been reduced by four people to ensure safe access to the toilets, with the alfresco area seating 16 persons. Procureur Corbett asked if it is his intention to operate the alfresco area in the evening. The applicant confirmed that is the plan and he is in discussion with the Parish and will accept any condition applied.</p> <p>There were no further questions from the Assembly, on being put to a vote the application was approved unanimously</p>
