



## **PAROISSE DE ST HELIER PARISH ASSEMBLY**

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of St. Helier will be held at 7pm on Wednesday 24 June 2026 at the Town Hall.

Parishioners are asked to take into consideration and, if deemed advisable:

1. To approve the Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on 27 May 2026\*;
2. Recommend to the Licensing Assembly an application by Matthew John Daly, holder of a 3rd Category licence in respect of Luma Cafe, 25 Halkett Street to vary the conditions of the licence to remove the restriction that only background music shall be played on the said premises.
3. To consider an application by Matthew John Daly, holder of a 3<sup>rd</sup> category licence in respect of Luma Cafe, 25 Halkett Street to apply for a Bailiff's Annual Entertainment Permit, to allow solo musicians only, such as a DJ or acoustic guitarist. Entertainment will take place no more than once a week and in the vast majority of cases at weekends (Friday or Saturday). These will be closed door functions e.g. birthday parties, within the permitted hours of the permit
